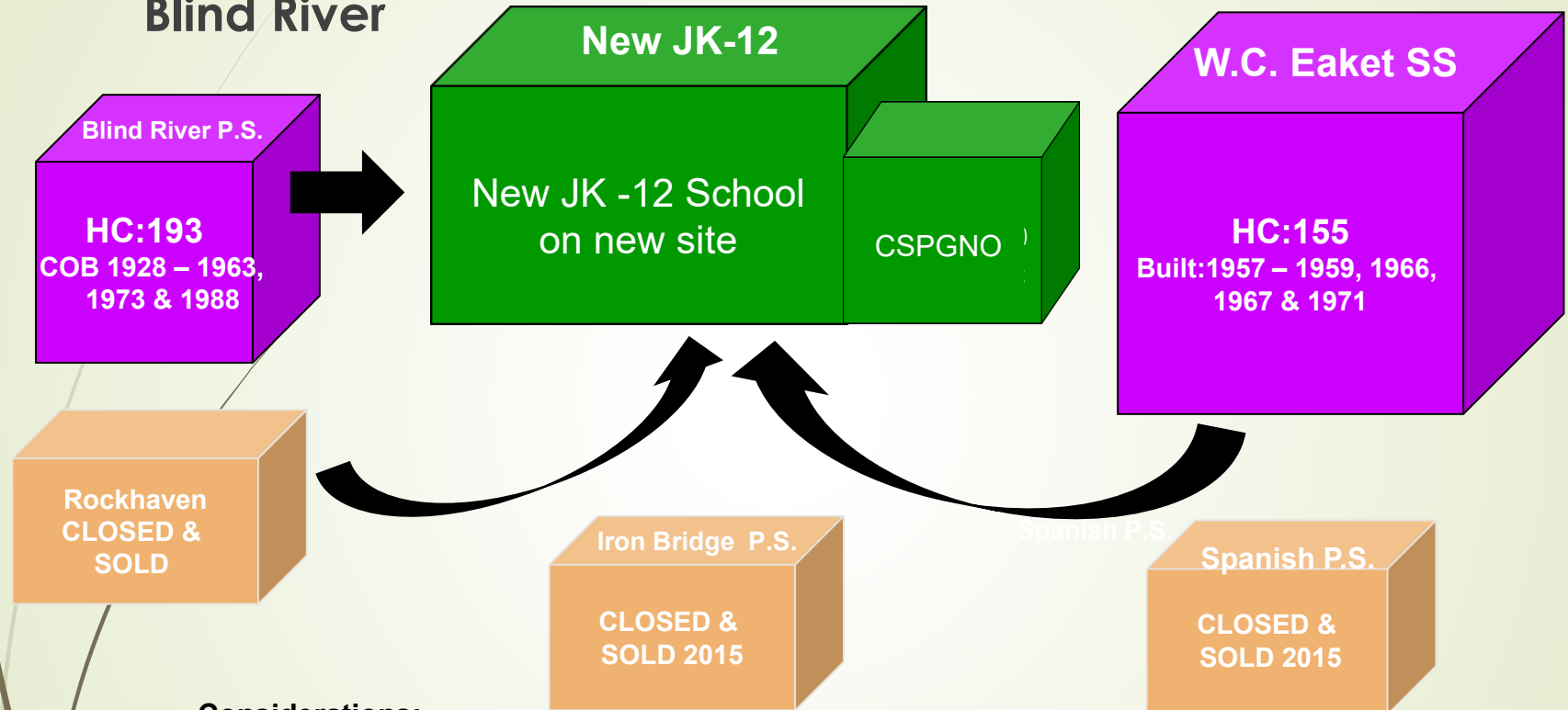

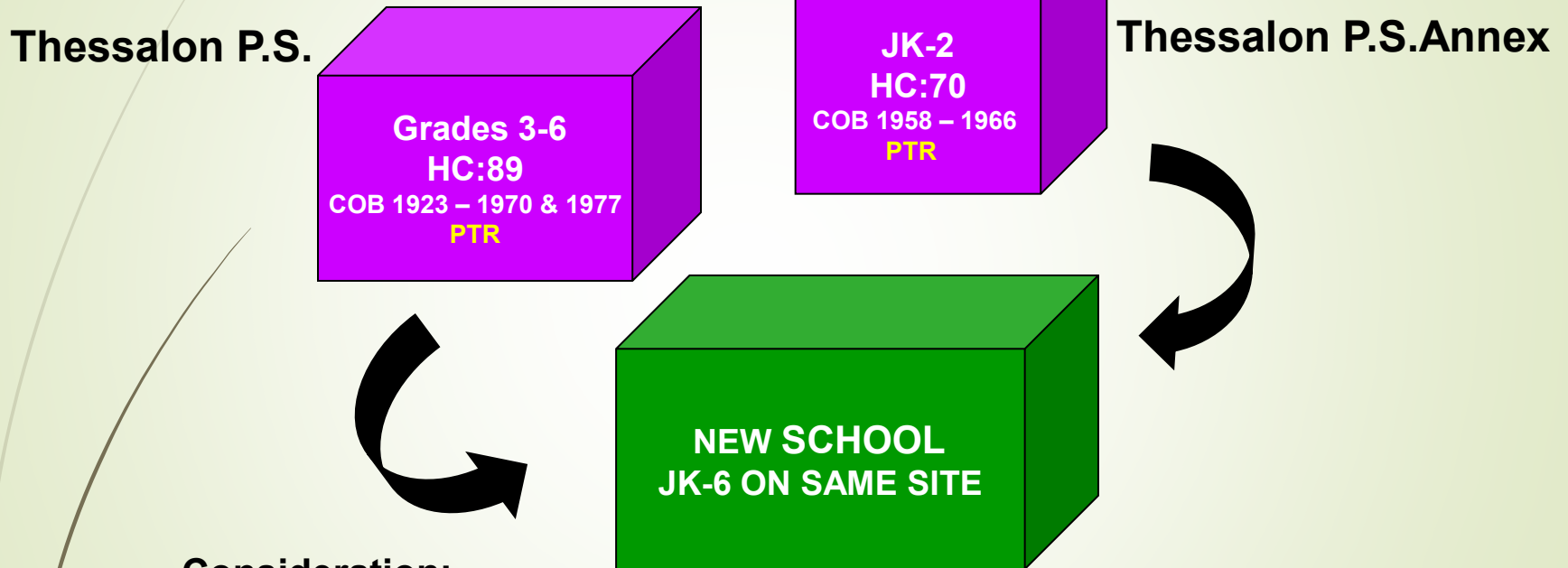


Considerations:

Thessalon P.S. (JK-6)

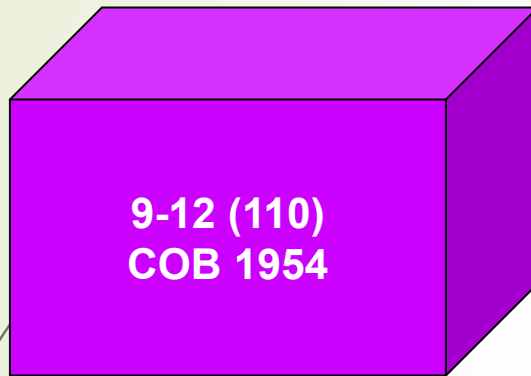


Consideration:

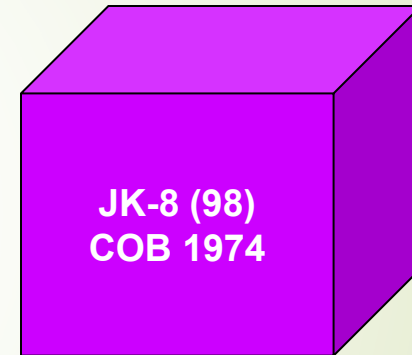
- Daycare utilizing/leasing 2 classrooms and kitchen in annex (since 2014)

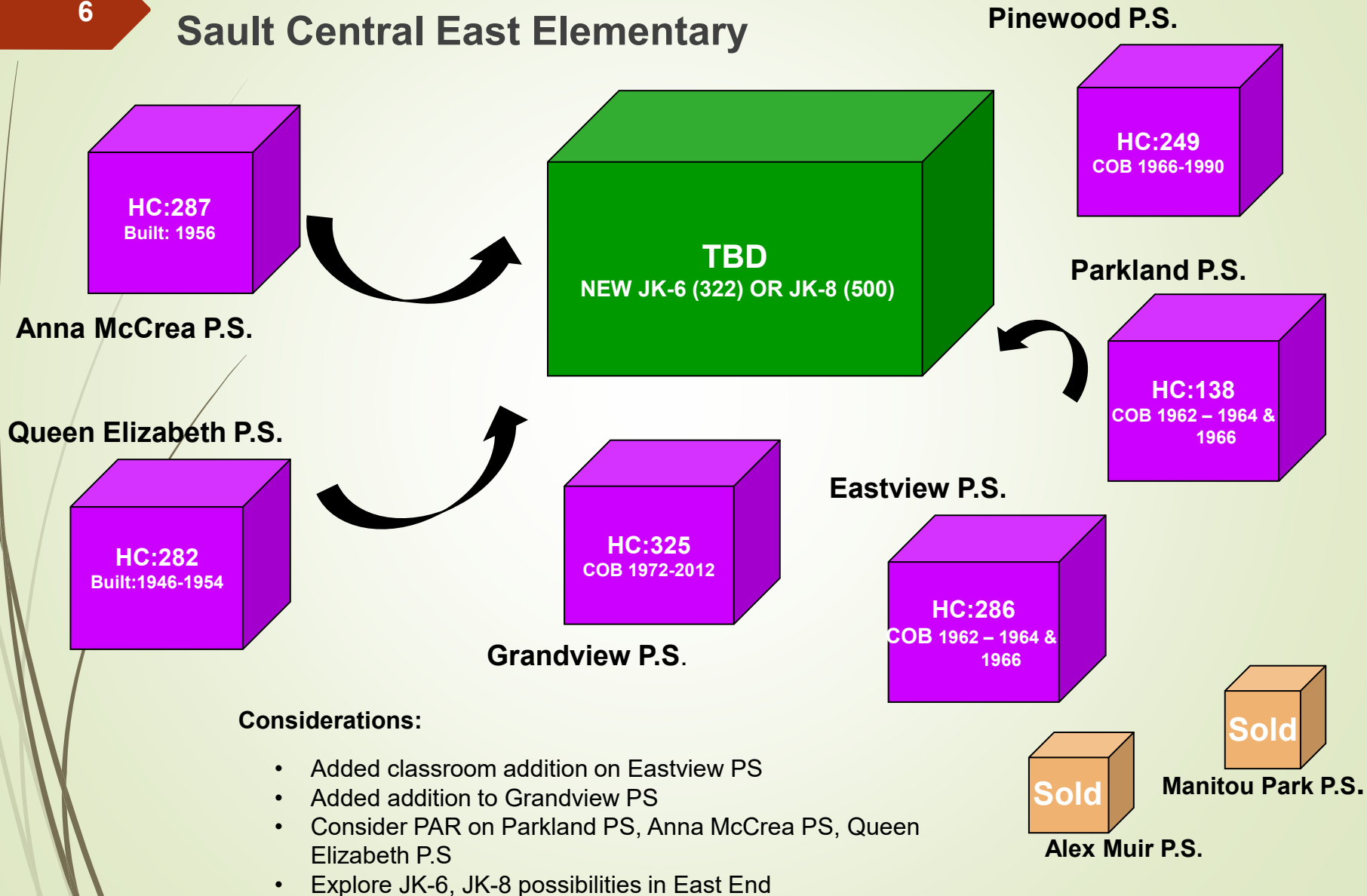
