2.1.0 Background

Governance

The audit committee operated throughout the fiscal year ending August 31, 2019. All of the members satisfied the eligibility requirements in accordance with Ontario Regulation 361/10.

External Auditors

The relationship with the external auditors has been satisfactory and private meetings were held during the year. The external auditors *KPMG* presented the scope and extent of their work to the committee, which the committee reviewed and recommended for approval at the October 15, 2018 meeting. The external auditors confirmed their independence at this meeting and in the letter dated November 27, 2018 appended to the 2017-18 Audited Financial Statements. The audit committee reviewed and recommended the approval of the annual audited financial statements on November 20, 2018. The audit committee recommended the reappointment of the external auditors for the next fiscal year during the meeting held June 10, 2019.

Internal Auditors

The relationship with the internal auditors has been satisfactory and private meetings were held during the year. The Committee reviewed the results of the risk assessment, as well as the risk-based internal audit plan (attached) for the 2019/20 fiscal year.

- Reviewed the fees paid to the external auditors in respect of other audit work undertaken during the year;
- Reviewed and evaluated the external auditors' performance;
- Reviewed and evaluated the effectiveness of the internal audit function, including the performance of the regional internal audit manager and his / her team;
- Queried management on their approach to risk management as well as their strategy to manage such risks; and
- Performed a self-assessment.
