BUILDING THE 7-12 COMMUNITY AT ELLIOT LAKE SECONDARY SCHOOL:

Our 7-12 Program provides students with a **gradual transition** into secondary school. Grade 7 and 8 students find themselves in a supervised, safe and more **mature learning environment** that includes specialty rooms, lockers, a cafeteria, athletics, extra-curricular clubs and laptop technology.

Depending on timetable availability, grade 8 students (in consultation with parents) can **reach ahead** and take a grade 9 class. They receive credit for the course giving them a head start in high school.
