The Superior Heights 7 & 8 Program

Our 7-12 program provides students with a gradual transition into secondary school. Students experience elements of secondary school which makes the transition to high school seamless as they have already been exposed to the school culture and environment. Grade 7 and 8 students are treated to specialty learning rooms, their own locker, a cafeteria, superior athletic facilities, extra-curricular clubs/teams and technology that supports their success. The grade 7 and 8 curriculum expectations are the same for all ADSB students. However, the curriculum in a 7-12 school can be taught differently because of the access to specialty facilities and subject-specific teachers. Students experience Rotary in their timetable which mirrors secondary school routines.



Leadership Opportunities

Superior Heights is dedicated to developing leadership opportunities for all students through Athletics, Environmental Initiatives and Leadership Councils. Students in grade 7 and 8 are encouraged to become active members of Student's Council, giving them a voice in decisions that are made which affect the entire student body, grade 7 to 12.
