Co-Operative Education

Students who have secured a summer job may be eligible to earn a Co-operative Education credit while gaining work experience and skills relevant to their future careers.

This course requires students to attend the first three days of summer school (June 30 – July 2) virtually to complete the Health and Safety, Well-being, and Pre-placement requirements and attend one integration and one summative session. Students must work a minimum of 20 hours a week during the month of July to be eligible for the credit.

The Co-operative Education teacher will work with students and the employer to develop and implement a Co-operative Education Learning Plan and monitor student progress at their work placement.
